Traineeship Course

A traineeship involves a student completing the qualification with both a beauty therapy salon and a registered training organisation. The trainee and their employer sign a contract to work together. The employer undertakes to train the trainee in all possible aspects of the qualification. The employer and trainee then engage a registered training organisation and negotiate a training plan to complete training for the units of the competency that the employer is unable to complete.

The Queensland School of Beauty offers theory lessons for trainees and any practical training that is required. All theory examinations and practical observations will be completed by the Queensland School of Beauty to ensure competence in the units of the qualification. Once the trainee is deemed competent in all units they will be issued with a Certificate IV in Beauty Therapy.

Students can also start a traineeship while they are at school. Please note this course is competency based therefore the duration may vary. It can take anywhere between 1-4 years to complete.
